## Trumpet Audition Rep, Fall 2024, ISCS


For the audition, you will perform:

- Three standard excerpts that represent common styles of orchestral playing. Be sure to transpose the excerpts as needed and listen to recordings to understand the style and musicality of each one (this can't be said enough). Listen to the whole piece to really understand how the excerpt fits into the work. Fall in love with the music. The more you listen, the more legit you'll sound. If you're real serious, track down the entire part and learn more of the piece instead of just the short excerpt.
- Prepare well in advance and avoid the pitfall of "Summer Chops". You want to be able to play these beautifully and convincingly, so practice in a consistent and daily manner to condition your face and mind for a great performance!
- Bb and/or C Trumpet may be used, but transpose as necessary. (C Trumpet is standard for these excerpts.)

Bartok, **Concerto for Orchestra**, *5. Finale. Presto*. (C Trumpet) Play the 2<sup>nd</sup> part. (1 and 2 are unison at [556])
